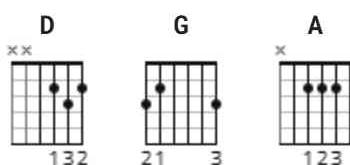
Description: Strumming pattern is your usual chugging Chuck Berry style thing.
